Designs & Layouts

Scotts is renowned for building Stables to meet your requirements and almost any shape and size can be accommodated within the Scotts design service. Every Stable is a one-off and Scotts can confidently claim to provide you a yard which is uniquely yours.



— U-Shaped Yard

For larger yards, requiring an efficient working environment, the U-shaped layout provides the best solution. Offering increased shelter and easy management of staff and horses.



— E-Shaped Yard

This layout is often employed within a commercial yard with additional buildings e.g. offices and workshops. Creating two distinct areas that are connected, often with shared facilities.



— Straight Line Yard

A straight line of loose boxes is significantly beneficial when space is at a premium, often chosen for private yards. It can also benefit large yards to stable horses temporarily in outlying areas.



— L-Shaped Yard

One of the more popular layouts, this L-Shaped yard provides a convenient and attractive option, particularly suited to a corner. Offering easy access to all boxes and effective shelter for the horses.

American Barns

A popular alternative to traditional timber Stables, American Barns are an efficient equestrian building accommodating everything under one roof.

Distinctly continental in style, the Scotts American Barns is popular in working yards, such as livery yards and riding schools. The American Barn design makes for a more efficient workplace and provides essential shelter from the elements when mucking out or grooming.





Supplied as Standard

- 1m overhang offering protection from the elements.
- Rear window and grille for each bay offering additional light into the American Barn building as well as ventilation. If preferred, top doors or glazed top doors can be supplied as well, or as an alternative.
- Ventilated ridge detail offering increased ventilation and allowing further light to enter the American barn. This feature also enhances the appearance of the overall building.
- Profile metal sheeting on the roof although other roof options can be accommodated. Internally, the American barn roof is insulated and then underlined with a fire-resistant boarding.
- Kicking board lining, to eaves height, in all stalls.
- Monarch internal partitions with the option of sliding or opening doors.


— The Commercial Yard

Many equestrian businesses, such as liveries, riding schools, equestrian 'holiday homes' and competition yards, require peace of mind with respect to the comfort and safety of their horses and rely on the experience from Scotts to enhance their business. Commercial yards often specify more practical layout designs, with the e-shaped yard being a firm favourite, typically incorporating a reception area, offices and toilets as well as the main loose boxes, tack and feed preparation areas.

— Walk Throughs & Arches

Design features such as walk-throughs and archways are a popular addition as they not only create a focal point to a yard but double up as wash down areas, storage for horse boxes and cover for the farrier, to name but a few possibilities.

— Cladding & Colour Choice

Scotts offers a choice of cladding along with paint and stain options for your Stables, which further adds a different finish and look to the Stable, depending on your final specification. You can also specify contrasting Stable doors to create a distinctive look.

— Architectural Features

Features such as rustic oak posts or hipped roofs can complete a Stable design which is exclusive to you.

— Roof Choices

Scotts offers a wide choice of roof finishes for your Stables to meet almost any requirement.

— Accessories

Clock towers, clocks and weathervanes all add visual interest to the Stables and are designed to combine tradition and beauty. They can add the perfect finishing touch to any Stable yard, however large or small.

— Bespoke Design Features

Sympathetic design features will ensure that your Stables will blend in with the existing architecture as it is often a legal requirement that the choice of materials are approved by the local authority prior to construction.

Internal Options

As standard, exterior grade, high density kicking boards are fitted to eaves height in all Scotts loose boxes. This moisture resistant boarding has extra timbers fitted behind it to improve performance and its durability has proven ample for most horses, over many years. The standard Scotts kicking board can be steam cleaned and, if required, can be painted to give a more traditional feel to the boxes.

Tack room interiors are, similarly, lined to eaves height and come complete with a flat ceiling to keep the tack in ideal conditions.

Scotts can provide mangers and tie rings within each loose box, saddle and bridle racks with each tack room and other fittings can also be supplied, at an additional cost.

— Cladding



The aesthetic appeal of a Stable yard is partly dependent on the exterior cladding and with Scotts you can choose the cladding to suit surrounding buildings or your personal taste.

Scotts utilises our own pattern vacuum pressure treated tongued and grooved shiplap cladding, as standard, which is affixed to a durable timber frame construction. Alternatively, you can specify rough sawn, rebated feather edged boarding, for a more rustic look or even specify your own special profile.

— Paint or Stain Finish



Scotts offers a wide variety of paint and stain finishes to enhance the individuality of your Timber Stables. The paint or stain is applied in the manufacturing process, ensuring all the tongues are individually painted, and a final coat is applied on site at the installation stage.

Additionally, your Stable doors, barge boards and finials can be painted in contrasting tones to enhance the overall appearance of your Stables, creating a distinctive and unique look.

Felt Tiles

These are cost effective and are available in a variety of colours and can be fitted on roofs up to a 30° pitch. Felt tiles are sometimes accepted as a replacement material for conventional tiles by local authorities.

Profile metal sheeting

A maintenance free, steel finish available in a wide choice of colours. Performance guaranteed for up to 30 years, offering peace of mind.

Tapcoslate Classic

TapcoSlate Classic offers enhanced performance to create a gorgeous roof that won't break or delaminate, survives substantial impact, is very light in weight, easy to install, no sorting, clipping or drilling, has a 40-year warranty.

Metrotile

A traditional looking roof tile manufactured from a lightweight steel, with asphalt finish, available in a choice of profiles and colours. Metrotiles are robust and heavy duty and give a high level of aesthetic satisfaction. Available in different profiles to easily blend in with surrounding buildings, replicating the look of a conventional tiled roof. Metrotiles have a 50 years, plus life expectancy.

Alternative Roof Choices

Alternatively, Scotts can supply trussed rafters to take clay or slate tiles, or cedar shingles, so that new buildings can match existing ones.
